


Interlaken Town

Interlaken Town provides recycling services, with a dumpster located at the town's DPW site, next to the garbage dumpsters at 326 Luzern Rd. You can recycle paper, cardboard, and certain plastics, but NOT GLASS. Only plastics that are identified by a number within a triangle are recyclable. For glass and other types of plastics (styrofoam, packing material, plastic bags, etc) you can drop off recycling at the Park City recycling center (see below). If you want curbside recycling for pickup at your home, ReCyclops recycling does bi-weekly pickups in town. Most recyclable materials will be picked up for a modest monthly fee. Park City Dropoff Recycling

For very complete and free recycling services, the Park City Recycling Center is a short drive away at 1825 Woodbine Way, Park City. It is open Mon-Sat from 10am to 5:30pm. Phone# is 435-649-9698, http://www.recycleutah.org/. There is no charge for dropoff recycling, but donations are strongly encouraged. Check their website for updates and changes to service.
